SCRIP WHAT IS IT?

When you order gift-cards through SCRIP, our club gets a percentage back! Gift cards cost face value. So \$25 gift card costs you \$25. When the percentage back to the club reaches \$25, YOU start to accrue 5-% of the percentage deemed from a retailer. The other 50% goes to SFSC!

Your profit comes in the form of Club credits. These credits can be used for SFSC logo wear, test sessions held at home and Spotlight on Ice fees. PrestoPay securely links a bank account to your shop-withscrip.com account so you can choose electronic debit when you checkout online. The rebate is automatically credited to SFSC, and you don't have to worry about cash or checks.
